



Foundation Transition - Important Dates 2025

Our Term 3 and Term 4 transition program allows our new students to experience life at Newlands Primary School. During these sessions, students will participate in a school tour, engage in Spanish sessions, experience an introduction to the Builder's Program and meet their future peers.

Term 3

Session 1. Friday August 29th: 9.05 – 10am - Getting familiar with the school

9.05 – 9.15	Families will arrive and meet in the quadrangle. Students will be marked off and will receive a name tag before beginning the session in one of the classrooms.
9:15 – 10am	<u>Parents and students will be in the classroom together.</u> The teacher will take the roll before the learning community goes on a school tour and they read the Newlands Social Story.
10am	Families depart Newlands Primary School

Session 2. Friday September 12th: 9.05 – 10am - Getting familiar with the classroom

9.05 – 9.15	Families will arrive and meet in the quadrangle. Students will be marked off and will receive a name tag before beginning the session in one of the classrooms.
9:15 – 10am	<u>Parents and students will be in the classroom together.</u> The teacher will take the role before the learning community begins a classroom scavenger hunt. This will be followed by other fun engaging experiences.
10am	Families depart Newlands Primary School.

Term 4

Session 3. Friday 23rd October: 9.05 – 10am - Getting Familiar with other students

9.05 – 9.15	Families will arrive and meet in the quadrangle. Students will be marked off and will receive a name tag before beginning the session in one of the classrooms.
9:15 – 10am	<u>Parents and students will be in the classroom together.</u> The teacher will take the role before the learning community begins a play-based builders program.
10am	Families depart Newlands Primary School.

Session 4. Friday November 14th: 9.05 – 10am - Getting Familiar with Newlands Learning

9.05 – 9.15	Families will arrive and meet in the quadrangle. Students will be marked off and will receive a name tag before beginning the session in one of the classrooms.
9:15 – 10am	<u>Parents will drop off their child at the quadrangle and will be encouraged to attend an information session*</u> . The teacher will take the role before the learning community begins a simplified builders program. <i>*An information session for parents regarding starting school and Out of School Hours Care will be provided.</i>
10am	Parents will collect their child from the classroom.

Session 5. Tuesday 9th December: 9am – 11am - Getting Familiar with my Classmates

8.50 – 9am	Families arrive at Newlands Primary School. Students will line up at their designated classroom with their 2024 class. This information will be provided in Term 4.
9am	The teacher will take the role before the learning community begins their session. Parents will drop off their child at the door and will be encouraged to attend a <u>'Welcome Morning Tea'</u> . <u>Students will need a snack on this day!</u>
10.55am	Parents will collect their child from the classroom.
